# STORY OF THE YEAR

ur year has been dominated by the launch of a social enterprise to help fund our mentoring service.

As a charity we have historically relied on grant funding but in contrast, the majority of organisations that we support are social enterprises: businesses that sell a service or product for their revenue. They have inspired us to work to fund our organisation with business revenue.

The idea to launch our speakers agency Expert Impact Speakers had been simmering for a while. Our asset was right in front of us: amongst the 85 Experts and nearly 500 social entrepreneurs in our network, we have a lot of valuable experience and insight. We knew that some of them were getting asked to speak at events without remuneration (sometimes alongside others who were being paid) which put a bit of fire in our belly to bring some equality to proceedings. Happily, the Postcode Innovation Trust thought we were onto something too, awarding us start-up funding in December 2021. We were thrilled that Venita Di Domenico, who has worked in the

years, chose to join us as Head of
Speakers before we launched in
February 2021. Our social purpose
attracted Venita to work with us and
her knowledge of the sector and client
expectations has proved invaluable.

All the things you have read about start-ups are true. Bloody hard work, good fun figuring it all out, daily challenges and constant learning. The lows of weekly challenges or failed strategies are matched by the highs that small victories bring to encourage us in thinking we've got a great business idea; the speakers who want to work with us or the sector sages who tell us the speakers market was ripe for disruption and we're a welcome fresh take. Then there are the high-profile clients we have attracted in our first few months. such as multinational bank Standard Chartered and the National Institute for Health and Care Excellence (NICE).

Expert Impact Speakers provides impactful speakers for any kind of event and uses the profits to help fund the mentoring service. We provide the full spectrum of speakers: keynote speakers for conferences, compères for awards

ceremonies, after-dinner speakers, entertainers, a facilitator or panellists for a discussion, or a headline speaker. Our roster includes people from business, academia and entertainment and we represent many diverse, ethically minded speakers passionate about improving society.

With a change in thinking about how we fund our organisation, all parties involved agreed a change of governance would be appropriate.

Expert Impact founder John Hunt graciously handed the reins over to Social Enterprise UK, whose CEO Peter Holbrook and Director of Finance Sabira Kanji became trustees, joined by Colin Downie of social enterprise Wildhearts Group.

It hasn't all been about speakers of course – our mentees are the reason we exist. As word of our unique proposition and excellent reputation in mentoring spread, new revenue streams opened up, with Camden Council asking if we could provide mentoring services for the Future Camden Fund, an initiative designed to fuel inclusive growth in the borough. Our influence spread far beyond London though, as we participated in group meetings as far apart as Plymouth and Redcar and Cleveland. We focused outreach on Scotland and enlisted a partner in Ireland in the shape of Clodagh O'Reilly, founder of Social Enterprise Solutions Ireland. Our impact statistics show we continue to bolster social enterprises across the UK, and we're aiming to increase our reach in 2022/23.

## **ACRE IMPACT CAPITAL MET GRAHAM THOMAS**

Founder Hussein Sefian is attempting to raise a fund of billions to build essential infrastructure such as hospitals, schools and sanitation underserved communities in Africa using a novel impact investing strategy. "When you are trying to do something new it can be a bit of a lonely place and it's good to have partners and mentors you can engage with," Hussein told us after we matched him up with Graham Thomas, a managing partner at private equity firm Stage Capital. "Graham was open to having follow-on conversations and was very generous in terms of helping make introductions with relevant people that could support our project. It's great that Expert Impact exists," said Hussein.

## **COMPARE ETHICS MET TOM ADEYOOLA**

Which way do you turn when faced with several directions? Abbie Morris, co-founder of Compare Ethics, a tech platform where brands are rated against their ethical claims, had just such a dilemma and was matched with Tom Adeyoola. "Tom was super knowledgeable and had great examples of his scaling challenges. He was clear we needed to be laser focused (on one thing). It really got us into a different mindset," said Morris. Two years on, 85% of their leads are inbound enquiries and their team has grown to six people. Just as important, it's helped with their social impact too.

## **WONKY FOOD COMPANY MET DIANA HUNTER**

The Wonky Food Company makes delicious relishes from food headed for landfill and co-founder Ashley Cavers was weighing up several ways to grow the business after three years of trading. Diana Hunter, who'd been instrumental in the growth of Sainsbury's and Waitrose, advised how she might build on what they had achieved. "As a company – and I can directly link this to Diana's advice – we have professionalized ourselves, we've grown up. So we're now having regular strategy meetings, we're very clearly setting ourselves targets and goals, and delegating tasks in a way that we didn't before." Wonky are now stocked nationally in Co-op stores.


